

## Divine Mercy

Fr Robert Maloney, a former Superior General of the Vincentian Community and the Daughters of Charity, tells a story about his two year old great niece, Maeve. Maeve was born with a life limiting condition but 'she lived and died evoking love and radiating it back.' Maeve's father said at her funeral, "Every time you saw her you wanted to kiss her."

In this year's Extraordinary Jubilee of Mercy Pope Francis wanted Christians in the Catholic tradition to appreciate more deeply just who God is and what God reveals of love in Jesus of Nazareth on whom God's favour rests so powerfully.

Imagine God saying of any or all of us, "Every time you saw her (him) you wanted to kiss her (him)." The terribly sad thing about many of us is we find this hard to believe. For various reasons we may fear we are not loved. Maeve was an entirely innocent young child but we know we aren't quite so blameless. All the same, God would still embrace each and all of us if only we would allow it.

We are restored in the forgiveness of God which simply means God's eternal joy at the prospect of embracing us in the same way the father embraces his lost son in the parable of the prodigal. God's forgiveness means God does not brood on our sin or lie in wait for retribution. God does not want to hit you back! God sees love in us trying to express itself, trying to allow us express ourselves and God knows it is innate in us. However unsure of ourselves we have become we also evoke love and radiate it back. Even before this, though, God wants to kiss us anyway.
