In the Bible the number seven was significant. Its importance comes from the account of creation in the book of Genesis at the start of the Bible. The seventh day became the Sabbath and the figure coloured so much in the religion and culture of Israel.

In my own experience the figure seven turns out to be significant as well, as it rounds off my term as parish priest of St Peter's, Phibsborough.

It has been seven years since the late Fr Brian Moore, who himself had been parish priest of St Peter's, asked me to come here. It was a tremendous honour and I knew it.

Being in St Peter's and working among you has been a privilege. You have befriended me and supported me and have always wished the best for the parish that gathers in communion when each of you walks through the doors of our beautiful church.

I have so much to be grateful for over the past seven years. It may sound odd but working in St Peter's showed me what being a priest really means. Family and parish are where the church takes shape, where communion begins, all the elements that make Eucharist possible.

Please remember in your prayers the work of the Vincentian Community wherever it takes place and those of us engaged in it. In Ireland, ever since the time of St Vincent himself, Irish Vincentians have worked hard to build up a faithful and confident Catholic people, one which the New Testament asks is able to give an account of the hope that is in us.

It has been a blessing to be part of that work among men and women who love God and the Church, and whose care for each other proves it. May God bless you and keep you and always smile on you. Thank you.
