Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe 20 November 2016



The Feast of Christ the King was introduced by Pius XI in 1925. The period between the wars saw the rise of all the 'isms' that the 20th century is famous for: fascism; nationalism; communism; socialism; secularism. All the ideologies which would clash in the next twenty years until the end of the Second World War. We're a long way from that period, but we are still gripped by competing ideologies. The feast emphasises that all these things will pass, and only the true nature of kingship in Jesus Christ will remain.

Plato said that the measure of a human being was what they did with power. For any in positions of leadership, in the home, at work, in pastime activities or interests, we are presented with opportunities to lead. Power is everywhere and the journey of the Christian life is learning how to understand it, how to use it wisely and well, and how to recognise its limitations.

It begs the question: are the people we encounter in life a way to get what we want; a way to get to the top of the pile or the front of the queue? Do we see people as a means to an end or, as Christ would have us see them, a source of love and grace? True leadership comes with a power that cannot be measured in anything human, but comes from the ability to lead by example, to never forget the weakest and more vulnerable, and to leave it aside when the time comes.

Why is it often that corrupt governments and totalitarian regimes seek to expel priests, religious and church leaders? Is it because people of faith believe in the form of leadership which can speak with genuine authority; which can seek and find the lost as a good shepherd is wont to do; which can end up on a cross, but can also leave a tomb empty three days later.


