The Ethiopia Deaf Project (EDP)...

... is a small group of people who work on a voluntary basis to raise funds to help support and sustain the Ambo Deaf School in Ethiopia. They're a sub-committee of the Vincentian Lay Missionaries and are passionate about working to ensure that the Deaf children in Ambo and surrounding villages can access education through sign language. They were instrumental in establishing the Ambo Deaf School and are responsible for its ongoing development. The Ambo Lazarist Deaf School was built in 2012 and employs three qualified teachers for the Deaf. The school offers the Deaf children in the area an opportunity for the first time ever to achieve their full potential in education. The establishment of the ALDS will help to break the stigma associated with deafness and disability, introduce Deaf Awareness training for parents and local society and offer Sign Language classes to parents allowing them to participate more fully in the life of their child and enhance the relationship between child and parent.
