


# St Peter's Church, Phibsborough Parish Newsletter

Third Sunday of Easter 30 April 2017



On a September morning in 1981 my parents and I set off in our VW Beetle (that's when it was a farmer's car) bound for Maynooth College. We joined the N7 at Fermoy and then passed through Cahir, Cashel and all the other towns long since bypassed. We pulled in at a lay-by near Abbeyleix and feasted on sandwiches and flasked tea, prepared for the journey by my Mum. I was daunted by my vocation but also strengthened by the support of my family and the divine stranger that I felt sure was travelling with us. I did not know it at the time, but with that simple food, at that moment in time and in that company, I was dining in God's Kingdom.

The image of life being a journey is central to the writings of St Luke. He called Christianity the religion of the Way. Implied in that concept is the knowledge that we are not perfect, but are pilgrims journeying to a goal. It is wonderful to know that the Risen Jesus walks with us (not ahead of or behind us), making sense of our experiences, especially the defeats and unrealised hopes that cause us to be 'downcast'.

In the Breaking of Bread, the two disciples were able to name the stranger who had walked with them as the Risen Lord. The allusion to the Mass is pretty obvious. When we gather as a group of disciples we too turn to the Scriptures, to make sense of our experience and broaden the horizons of our understanding. We may, like the Emmaus disciples, be 'astounded' by the claims of our faith that, in Jesus, we have God's pledge of eternal life.

In the sacred meal, which we are about to celebrate, may we too know that he is with us. May the fire of divine love also burn in our hearts as we return to the Jerusalem of our daily lives ready to share the Good News.

# **Parent & Toddler Group**






