An Invitation...

This Sunday marks the beginning of a very special journey of preparation towards First Holy Communion for the second-class boys and girls of St Peter's national school. The parable of the wedding in today's Gospel was spoken when Jesus saw that his own people were moving to reject him. The story is symbolic. But the invitation to us is a real one. The Holy Communion enrolment Mass is an invitation to the children and their families to prepare to come to know Christ in the most intimate way we know which is through the Eucharist.

The invitation that Matthew speaks about is an invitation to aim at the good life. The invitation to the kingdom of heaven is cast wide, yet we are free to say yes or no. No matter who we are in this life, we are welcome. When we come to Mass we shake off the rags of our injustice and our faults. Instead we dress in the clothes of a new, more loving person. We ask God to help us to respond as best as we can to this real invitation. God invites us to draw close, not because of our worthiness or in thanks for our efforts, but in a generous sharing of life. The time of prayer is part of our response: we will give ourselves wholeheartedly to God. The 'wedding garment' we wear is our awareness of our hand before God. We pray that we may remain humble, be conscious of how blessed we are and grow in trust as we respond to God's Spirit in our lives.

Personally I can recognise myself among the invited guests who stayed away. There may have been times when I've felt not worthy of God's Love, my attention was elsewhere, not living as God wants me too, not listening to God's concern for me. However I am here now, not because of my own doing or arrangement, but because I am responding to God's persistence. God is always seeking me out, but I sometimes focus only on my search. Often in the quiet times of the day I ask God to help me, to respect His word, to notice where He speaks to me, to receive His message in my heart and to respond worthily.

The grace and mercy of God are free for all who will accept them with a grateful heart. The wedding invitation is extended to everyone, and God provides our wedding garments for us. He offers us the garments of baptism, reconciliation, Eucharist. He offers to take us into his keeping, forgive us our wrong doings, feed us with his body and blood. This Sunday I ask you to keep the children who are preparing for First Holy Communion in your prayers, that they will accept His initivation to come to know His love and mercy for them through the Eucharist.

A Word on the Word




