

A Brief History of Love

God does not have favourites, Peter tells us. You wouldn't think that was the case sometimes, listening to some of the people who purport to speak on his behalf.

When Professor Stephen Hawking passed away earlier this year, people from all walks of life paid tribute to his brilliance, his scientific legacy, his courage and his sense of humour. Professor Hawking's work taught the world so much about the boundless mysteries of the universe, Though he considered himself an atheist, he believed that life had meaning, and that we should always be curious about how the universe came into existence. He believed in love, and is quoted as saying 'It would not be much of a universe if it wasn't home to the people you love'.

Any yet, after his death, there were some who couldn't resist the opportunity to ask: where is he now, this man who did not believe in God? The judgement and lack of compassion was staggering, coming as it did from 'Christian' commentators. Where is the love in such attitudes?

Today we bring everything back to the one word: love. There are more than 20 references to love in today's readings. God's love does not discriminate. In the second reading we hear that 'everyone who loves is begotten by God and knows God', while 'anyone who fails to love can never have known God, because God is love.' That love that God showed by sending his Son for us, is the same generous, wholehearted, self-sacrificing love we are called to show others - whether their beliefs align with ours or not. God does not have favourites.



Trocaire

We understand there are still some parishioners on our waiting list for the Parish Radio. Our supplier has let us down but fortunately we have since found a new supplier and we will contact all the names on the list when they arrive. Apologies for the delay.

Tax Relief Donation Scheme

As a registered charity St Peter's Parish can claim tax relief on monies donated. This means if you donate a minimum of €250 in one year, St Peter's is entitled to receive tax relief from the Revenue Commissioners at whatever rate you pay, either 20% or 41%. It applies to all cheque and cash donations which are made in instalments over the year or as one donation during that time. Standing orders also qualify.

This applies to PAYE ONLY individuals. It applies to donations to ST PETER'S PARISH ONLY (first Sunday collection). It does not apply to Share (second Sunday collection) or any Gate Collection except the one for Church Repairs, which is a St Peter's Parish collection. Examples:

- (a) Individual on the standard rate of tax, i.e. 20%. You donate €250.Tax relief to St Peter's = €50.
- (b) Individual on the higher rate of tax, i.e. 41%. You donate €250.Tax relief to St Peter's = €102.50.

St Peter's can only claim tax relief on money if we know who it has come from. This is why we ask you to identify all donations to St Peter's by putting your contact details on Weekly Envelopes, Christmas Dues, Easter Dues, November Lists and the monthly Gate Collection for essential Church Repairs. If you have donated €250 to St Peter's in 2017 please fill in a CHY4 Cert available from the Parish Office or online at: www.revenue.ie as soon as possible as our administrator Marion McCormack will be registering all donors with the revenue service by the end of May. Thank you to those who have already filled in and returned the form.


