Lessons in Humility

Originally published in 1986, the work Osez Croire, Osez Vivre - (Dare to Believe, Dare to Live) - is described by one publisher as a series of articles, conferences, sermons and interviews by Jean Marie Lustiger. And so it is. Amusingly it is also categorised as a work of fiction, by some in the literary world. The book offers an insight into the mind and outlook of the émigré Jean Marie Lustiger, the Jew turned Catholic, the man who became a priest, then Archbishop of Paris from 1981 to 2005. Lustiger sought both to engage the message of Christ with the liberal world in which he ministered, and also with the then-impending third millennium and the issues and viewpoints of modern man and woman. At the core of Lustiger's conviction is that true human freedom is only found in God as made known to us in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The setting of Lustiger is guite different than the gospel setting today in Nazareth, but the challenge is essentially the same. Only in encountering Jesus Christ and in growing in our relationship with him, do we find the real answers about who we are, who our neighbours and families are, what life and liberty are actually for, and what profound hope and possibility they afford us. Not to know the carpenter's Son, is not to know either oneself, or anyone else.
