### HOLY WEEK

Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday when the people welcomed Jesus as He entered Jerusalem with shouts acclaiming Him as the Messiah, 'Blessings on Him who comes in the name of the Lord!' They greeted Him by placing palm branches on the ground in front of Him.

The blessed palms in the shape of a cross evokes the bitter sweet nature of cries of welcome that would soon turn to shouts of 'crucify'. They remind us of the cost to God of His merciful love for us. The tradition of placing blessed palm in our home expresses our welcome to the Saviour and our trust in the power of Him who has brought us salvation.
