# SEPTEMBER, A VINCENTIAN MONTH

Several feasts of the Vincentian Family occur in September including five French Vincentians martyred in the French Revolution (2nd September) and St John Gabriel Perboyre, to whom there is a shrine in the Church, martyred in China in the 19th century (11th September). Blessed Frederic Ozanam, Founder of the Society of



St Vincent de Paul, is commemorated on 9th September and the Feast day of St Vincent de Paul takes place on 27th September.

Throughout September at the weekend Masses members of the different branches of the Vincentian Family will give a short reflection/testimony on what it means to them to live out the spirit of St Vincent. This weekend Sr Mary Crosbie, Daughter of Charity will speak at the 6.30pm vigil Mass and Mr Dermot McGilloway of the Society of St Vincent de Paul will speak at the 10.00am and 11.30am Masses.

The Feast of St Vincent de Paul will be celebrated at 7.30pm Mass on Tuesday, 27th September. The Chief celebrant will be Fr James Murphy CM. All are invited to this celebration which is a high point for us as a parish in the Vincentian tradition. Refreshments will be served after Mass and devotional items associated with the Vincentian Family (Miraculous Medals, red and green scapulars) as well as literature on the different branches of the Vincentian Family will be available. Please note that there will be no 10.30am Mass on Tuesday 27th September.

# LITURGICAL READINGS FOR: Sunday, 4 September 2022

### FIRST READING

A reading from the Book of Wisdom

'What man indeed can know the intentions of God? Who can divine the will of the Lord? The reasonings of mortals are unsure and our intentions unstable; for a perishable body presses down the soul, and this tent of clay weighs down the teeming mind. It is hard enough for us to work out what is on earth, laborious to know what lies within our reach; who, then, can discover what is in the heavens? As for your intention, who could have learnt it, had you not granted Wisdom and sent your holy spirit from above?

Thus have the paths of those on earth been straightened and men been taught what pleases you, and saved, by Wisdom.' The Word of the Lord.

### **RESPONSORIAL PSALM**

Response: O Lord, you have been our refuge from one generation to the next.

have liked to keep him with me; he could have been a substitute for you, to help me while I am in the chains that the Good News has brought me.

However, I did not want to do anything without your consent; it would have been forcing your act of kindness, which should be spontaneous. I know you have been deprived of Onesimus for a time, but it was only so that you could have him back for ever, not as a slave any more, but something much better than a slave, a dear brother; especially dear to me, but how much more to you, as a blood-brother as well as a brother in the Lord. So if all that we have in common means anything to you, welcome him as you would me.

### GOSPEL

A reading from the Gospel according to Luke

Great crowds accompanied Jesus on his way and he turned and spoke to them.

If any man comes to me without hating his father, mother, wife, children, brothers, sisters, yes and his own life too, he cannot be my disciple.

Anyone who does not carry his cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. 'And indeed, which of you here, intending to build a tower, would not first sit down and work out the cost to see if he had enough to complete it? Otherwise, if he laid the foundation and then found himself unable to finish the work, the onlookers would all start making fun of him and saying, "" Here is a man who started to build and was unable to finish". Or again, what king marching to war against another king would not first sit down and consider whether with ten thousand men he could stand up to the other who advanced against him with twenty thousand? If not, then while the other king was still a long way off, he would send envoys to sue for peace. So in the same way, none of you can be my disciple unless he gives up all his possessions."
